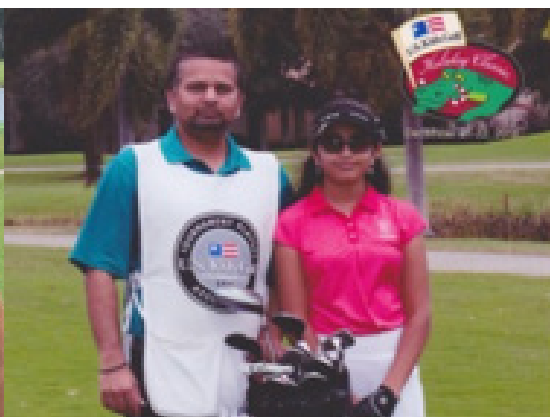
LEADERSHIP AND EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

A great way to do so is by supporting the Leadership and Educational Opportunities Scholarship Fund, which was established in 2013 under the generous initial funding of David and Karen Della Penta. This scholarship allows qualifying The First Tee of New Hampshire participants to further their education or take part in leadership or educational opportunities offered by the national The First Tee. The fund was initially established with a five-year total commitment of \$50,000. **Our goal is to reach \$100,000, which would provide annual funding of these scholarship opportunities for qualified participants.**
